

TEACHING AND LEARNING

The unique blend of modern and traditional courses on offer at Alsop means that all students have the opportunity to master their learning.

All teaching at Alsop High School is informed by a deep knowledge of the educational research that underpins excellent outcomes for young people. Our curriculum and lessons focus on equipping our students with the knowledge they need to succeed.

We pride ourselves upon our commitment to recognise and address the educational needs of our students. We ensure they access a broad and balanced curriculum and support their academic progression and examination success. As well as academic achievement there is a focus on character building, developing teamwork and independent learning to ensure students possess the skills to be lifelong learners.

Students at Alsop are supported by teachers who are experts in their field. Regular and meaningful homework is designed with a deep understanding of the demands of modern learning and the opportunities offered by the latest research into cognitive science.
